

Prof. Cristiano Vezzoni informed the Ethics Committee of the University of Milan that he is going to conduct the following research: "Generational gap and post-ideological politics in Italy – A generation-aware analysis of ideological destructuring and political change in the Italian case".

The POSTGEN project has a three-year duration and has been funded by the Ministry of University and Research (MUR) as part of the PRIN (Projects of National Interest) program, with the project ID: 2020TZJP52. The project involves four Italian universities: Luiss Guido Carli in Rome, University of Milan, Alma Mater Studiorum - University of Bologna, and University of Pavia. The research will focus on the ideological destructuring and political change in Italy, with a specific emphasis on the values and sociopolitical attitudes of young people, using a multi-method approach that includes observational analysis of social media, surveys with high school students, in-depth interviews with both young and older individuals, and a national survey with a representative sample of the Italian population.

The Ethics Committee of the University of Milan examined and issued a favourable opinion on the project.
