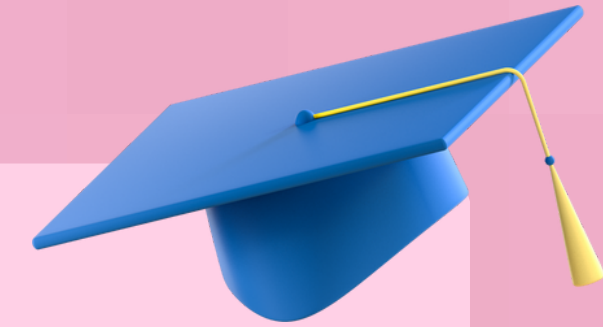
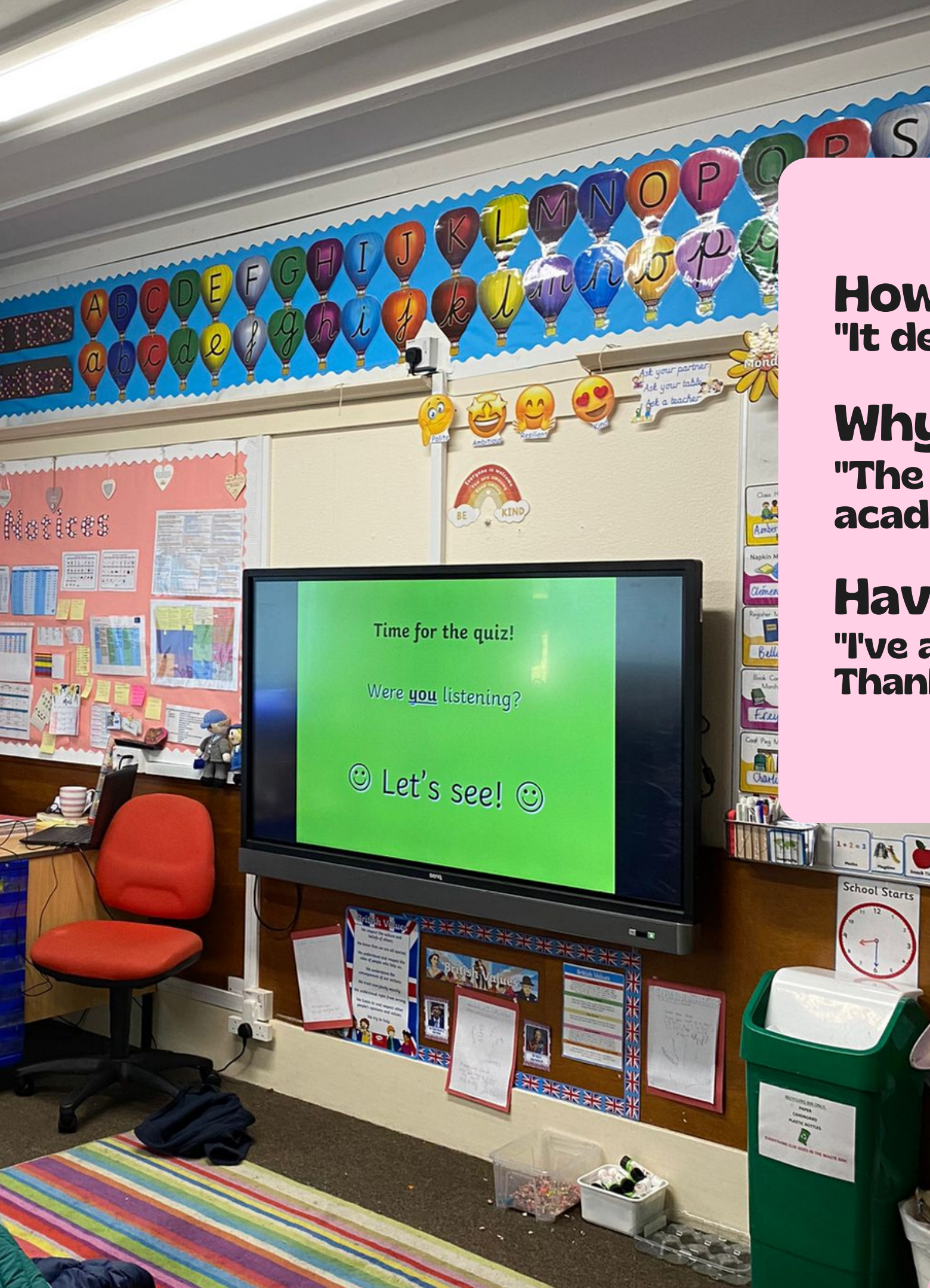
Do you help your children with their homework or are they independent?
