SUBJECTS AND SCHOOL SYSTEM

For Glenmoor & Winton Academies it is important to be inclusive and to show that every student matters.

The lessons are organised to allow all the most capable learners to be academically challenged while providing expert support to those with special educational needs and disabilities.

The students have access to a great number of extracurricular opportunities, spanning sports, STEM (science, technology, engineering, and mathematics), expressive arts, student leadership, fundraising and house charity events.

The main subjects are: English, mathematics, science and religion but they can also choose other subjects according to their preferences, like music, drama club or languages (spanish and french).

Some of the students declare that teachers are good and available, but also very strict, although it's a good thing because they learn better. In fact, as a demonstration of the efficient school system, this is one of the schools with the best exam results and grades in the whole area.

Everyday they have four periods, each one lasts 1.15 hours, a break of 20 minutes and a lunch break of 35 minutes. They have a canteen but they bring their own food because the prices are quite expensive and the meals aren't extremely healthy.

In conclusion we can claim that the system of the Italian school is different from the British one.

We notice some differences, for example in the British school there are more activities like cooking club, drama club, music club, pride and diversity club and also you can choose different sports like football, rugby, basketball and tennis.

Right after we observed their type of education, we think that they have some pros and cons, as for the pros the British school gives more opportunities their students to increase their passions thanks to the clubs. As for the cons the students receive harsh punishment like, for example, when they forget their homework.

We think that the Italian school could improve if they adopt techniques similar to the British one like creating some clubs or by giving the opportunity to the students to practice art or sports activities.
